Who We Are

Holcomb Crisis Intervention offers a crisis program to assist children, adolescents and adults experiencing varying levels of crisis. Services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and are free to the residents of Berks County. Holcomb Crisis Intervention has a culturally diverse staff, including individuals fluent in Spanish.

Holcomb Behavioral Health System is a behavioral health network meeting community needs for treatment, rehabilitation, and education in locations throughout Pennsylvania, Delaware, and New Jersey.

Holcomb Behavioral Health Systems has earned The Joint Commission's Gold Seal Approval.



Holcomb Crisis Intervention provides three distinct services:

- Telephone Crisis Counseling
- Community-Based Mobile Outreach
- Walk-in Center (Monday - Sunday, 9am – 5pm)

Services are provided by an experienced and culturally diverse staff who:

- Provide telephone crisis assessment/triage, counseling interventions, and service referrals.
- Provide rapidly-deployed mobile interventions throughout the community when greater intervention is required.
- Focus efforts on identifying alternatives to psychiatric hospitalizations whenever possible.
- Facilitate voluntary and involuntary psychiatric hospitalizations when clinically necessary.
- Support recovery-oriented principles by instilling hope and social connection.
